Patches

- Fixed issue where the privileged setting for tag was not being populated properly when editing tag settings.
- Fixed issue where deleting multiple words from the Elasticsearch common word list at once would produce an error.
- Reverted document folder functionality to allow for a single document to exist in multiple folders.
- Fixed issue where running saved searches from the folder view would produce an error.
- Extracting text entities in Elasticsearch is no longer on by default.
- Fixed various parsing issues with Elasticsearch searching that should cause searches to fail. For example, searching for “FW:” would previously produce an error in hit reports.
- Increased specificity of messages on login screen to distinguish between various error cases.
- Fixed parsing of specific timezone identifiers for time and datetime metadata field types.
- Altered tag profile creation to allow the adding of metadata fields initially below tags.
- Removed option for enabling/disabling document folder searching.
- Fixed issue where in some circumstances cancelling productions would cause a large number of log entries.
- Removed text search cache.
- Fixed error that caused print jobs to error out under specific circumstances.
- Switched PDF generation library to provide more standard, consistent, and modern PDF files.
- Added third-party license pack to Reveal installations.
